## LOCATED IN NEW ZEALAND'S SMALLEST AND MOST VISITED NATIONAL PARK AT THE TOP OF THE SOUTH ISLAND.

Surrounded by pristine waterways and native forest, the Lodge has been constructed to make the most of its secluded location. Choose from charming Standard or Family rooms or the architecturally designed Superior Suites built over the wetlands. The main lodge is warm, inviting and full of character with a comfy lounge, library, day spa and bar and a restaurant which is open to day visitors, many of whom have been walking the famous coastal track. Awaroa Lodge is beautifully secluded with no direct road access meaning arrival options by water are unique and spectacular and should be arranged at the time of booking.

The Lodge is a 20 minute walk along the beach and along a flat well formed woodland walking trail. Luggage is transferred by buggy. The lodge opens between October and April and closes during winter.

## DINING AT AWAROA LODGE

Harakeke Restaurant is open for breakfast, lunch and dinner and has its own organic garden; seasonal produce is used within the regionally influenced menus. Dine inside or out; the glasswalled conservatory has views out over the wetlands or the cafe with its outdoor courtyard is the perfect sunny spot to relax with a coffee. For casual relaxed dining head down to the outdoor pizzeria set in a glade of native trees; popular with passing track walkers.

## ACTIVITIES AT AWAROA LODGE

Whether you walk a section of the Abel Tasman Coastal Track, or simply take a stroll around the grounds and down to the beach, there are lots of options during a stay at the Lodge. Guided kayaking trips are available (book on arrival) or pre-book with one of our many partner operators in the park for a cruise, guided walk, sailing trip or helicopter tour. On wet days make the most of the roaring fireplace, a delicious hot chocolate and the company of your fellow guests or a book from the library shelves.

## GETTING TO AWAROA LODGE

Due to our remote location the Lodge is not accessible by road so the quickest way to reach us is by water or helicopter transfer. Please ensure you make transfer arrangements at the time of booking; talk to Awaroa Lodge about packages and pricing.

<b>From Nelson</b>	Abel Tasman SeaShuttle Bus Transfer will collect you from your Nelson hotel and transfer you to Kaiteriteri to meet their large and comfortable cruising catamaran for a scenic cruise to Awaroa Bay. Allow up to 3 hours.
<b>From Kaiteriteri</b>	Abel Tasman Seashuttle scheduled daily departures year round from Kaiteriteri as above; secure car parking is available for Lodge guests – please enquire. Allow 1.5 hrs for cruise. Abel Tasman Sailing Adventures offer options to do a sail transfer to and/or from Awaroa Lodge – contact them directly for bookings
<b>From Marahau</b>	Abel Tasman Aqua Taxi departing from Mārahau, the Abel Tasman Aqua Taxi operates a small boat which gets you close to the scenery and wildlife on the way. Designed for the more adventurous, the Aqua Taxi will get you to the lodge with speed.
<b>On Foot</b>	Awaroa Lodge offers an opportunity to discover one of New Zealand's Great Walks. Guests arriving at the lodge can walk part of the coastal track and have their luggage brought over on a water taxi. The lodge is the ideal place to spend the night on the second day of the walk, if you are departing from Mārahau. Allow up to 2 days. Freedom walk/unguided refer to doc.govt.nz for more details.
<b>By Air</b>	Helicopters Nelson offers an airport to lodge transfer, leaving from Nelson Airport and landing directly at the airstrip at Awaroa Lodge. They can cater for 4 passengers plus limited luggage.
