Activities on site include a tennis court, outdoor pool, yoga space and jacuzzi and a dry sauna. On site team building activities can be arranged.


Explore the region on a local wine tour, visit the outstanding Scupltureum or the famous Matakana Farmers market, or get active with a trip to one of the regional parks.
